

## September 2010 Class Schedule for Janie H. Knits

First, a word about payment: Prepayment is required for all classes. With paid registration, students receive a 10% discount on all class supplies. We ask that all yarn and patterns be purchased at Janie H. Knits. In case of cancellation of a class by us, students will receive a full refund. Students who drop classes will receive a store credit. You may register by calling the shop at 613-326-0626 with a credit card, or drop in to see us.

Second, a word about pricing: you will see that our pricing is quite varied this term. Our standard price is \$18 for a one-session course, \$35 for a two-session course, and \$50 for a 3-session course. Our Help Times have a fee now -- if your question or problem takes 10 minutes or less, we will be happy to help you free of charge. But if your problem is more difficult and requires more time, or you wish to stay and knit during this time, the charge is \$5. Our Knit-alongs are \$5 per time you attend. We will be learning along with you, so the nominal charge is to cover the cost of coffee, tea and turning on the lights!

This session at Janie H Knits, we're focusing on small projects as well as large ones in the Sweater Club. The idea is to learn something new and have fun. Also, we have 2 guest teachers joining us this term. We're very excited about being able to offer some fresh ideas to our customers, and hope that you will enjoy their offerings. Come and join us every second Thursday afternoon to knit for your favourite cause. Work on chemo caps, Izzy dolls, prayer shawls, or whatever you wish. No cost and no need to register.



**Fridays September 17 & 24 @ 10:15 a.m. -- Austria Scarf** This is a beautiful design by Ilga Leja of Nova Scotia and is knit with St. Denis' Nordique. You will learn provisional cast on, cables and some basic lace techniques as you create this cozy scarf and support Canadian companies. Cost is \$40 plus supplies.

**Saturday September 18 @ 10:00 a.m. -- Sock Club begins**

Introducing our new Sock Club! We will meet every second month to explore new patterns, designers, yarns and techniques. Every sock pattern will be different and will focus on a particular technique -- it will be a surprise, to be revealed on the day of the club! Participants will receive the pattern, yarn, a techniques sheet and suggestions for a more challenging sock to further their knitting in each style. There will be instruction on the day of the club. Cost is \$45 per project.

We will learn how to use two strands of hand dyed yarns, to eliminate pooling of colours -- a handy technique anytime you have to blend colours or dyelots. Cost is \$20 plus supplies
